Rules For The Arnold Livingstone League – 2021 (Rev. 3)

1. Only one shot on first 2 ends.
2. No dead ends. Jack to be replaced 2 meters from the ditch. If there is a wood there, the jack is placed in front of the wood.
3. 18 ends to be completed by 12:30pm with a minimum of 15 ends to be played to count, even if the time needs extending.
4. An end begins as soon as the jack is delivered. If the final bell goes before the jack is centred, the end must still be played.
5. In case of stoppage, ten ends must have been played to count. If less, teams share points.
6. If the day is rained off, the teams will share the points or we will try to play the games at a later date.
7. If a team fails to turn up without notice, the opponents will be the winners with 7 points added to their score. 7 points will also be deducted from the team that failed to turn up who will be responsible for the £18.00 total due for both teams.
8. When a substitute plays their first game for a team, (a) they cannot skip in that game and (b) they becomes part of that team and cannot substitute for any another team.
9. In the event of a team arriving with one player missing due to them being taken ill in the morning or from the night before, the **League Committee – George Taylor and Martin Greenfield** – reserve the right to appoint a substitute of their choice.
10. If a team is short one player, they can play with each of their players having 4 bowls with the opponents (a) bowling 3, 3 and 2 bowls, and (b) getting a further 30% (rounded) onto their score.
11. The cost will be £3.00 per playing player per week. Tea and prizes included.
12. Two teams will be promoted and two teams will be demoted at the end of the season (unless one of the promoted teams drops out of the league).
13. The league committee will alone decide all queries and matters that arise. Their decisions will be final.
